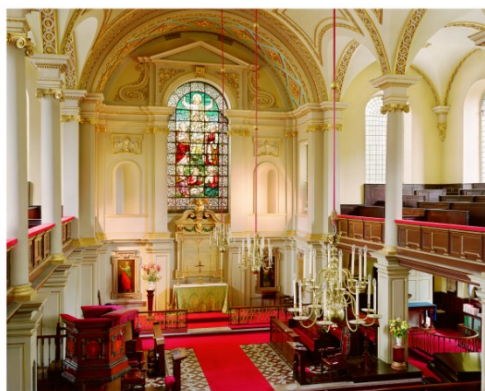


Harvest Thanksgiving Service
