Financial provision

- Quarterly grants for elderly or disabled beneficiaries
- Guidance on state benefits and help in claiming entitlements
- Emergency financial assistance towards domestic bills

Daily living

- Home help payments for elderly people in their own homes
- Grants for telephone line rental and lifeline pendant alarms
- Help with residential care home fees
- Accommodation in our two residential homes and other retirement facilities

Special situations

- Specialist equipment for people with disabilities
- One-off grants for replacing essential household equipment
- Paying for help on the farm in cases of serious illness or bereavement
